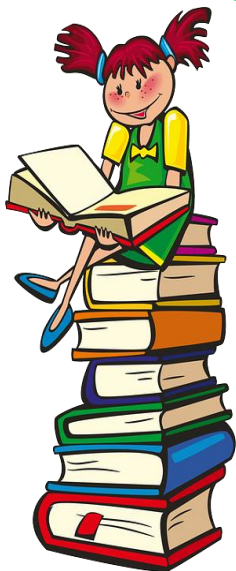

What are we learning in 5th Grade?

Math – Students will use models and strategies to solve real-world and word problems involving multiplication and division.

ELA – Students will be able to describe pages read and how they contribute to the overall structure of the story. Students will be able to describe historical settings and determine the gist and meaning of unfamiliar words and phrases. Students will be able to determine main ideas and summarize items read. Students will be able to quote accurately from the text.

Science – Human Body Systems – Students will understand why organisms differ from or are similar to their parents based on the characteristics of the organism. Students will be able to understand how structures and systems of organisms (including the human body) perform functions necessary for life.
